- ( ) Letters of recommendations that you may have received supporting this application as described in **E**.
- ( ) Required information on grants and scholarships listed in **F**.
- ( ) Print your name on the top right corner of each page, including attachments.
- ( ) Bind your application and the supporting documents securely.
- ( ) **Remember** your completed scholarship application must be delivered to the BREVARD VETERANS MEMORIAL CENTER OFFICE TO THE **LIBRARY STAFF MEMBER ON DUTY AT 400 Sykes Creek Parkway, Merritt Island, Florida. Your application must arrive NOT LATER THAN ONE O'CLOCK Friday, June 27, 2025.**
